Located in the financial center of the world, the Columbia MSFE Program provides its graduates with both a strong theoretical and a practical foundation in all aspects of financial engineering, from knowledge of financial markets and instruments through financial modeling in a variety of areas, programming and data analysis. The Program commences in July and is flexible, allowing students to graduate within one academic year by May, the end of the summer or December, based on their educational and career objectives. The first half of the program focuses on core courses and fundamental skills; the second half provides electives in a wide variety of areas on both the buy-and sell-sides of the financial industry.

The Columbia MSFE program has a dedicated MSFE Career Placement Officer who works with the Industrial Engineering and Operations Department Career Team as well as Columbia University's Center for Career Education to meet the unique career development needs of every student. Columbia University is dedicated to assisting students in professional development, providing resources that include not only education but also resume and cover letter writing, developing professional appeal and interview/networking skills.
